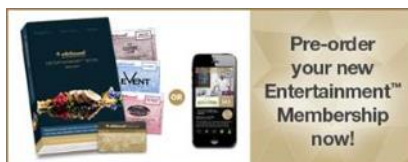

Thursday 30 Jun 11am-1pm (with crèche)**

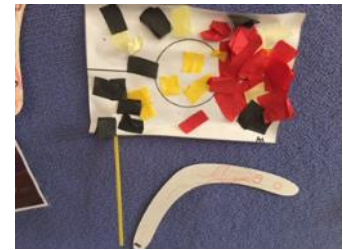
Fee: \$25/person (babies can attend with parent)
