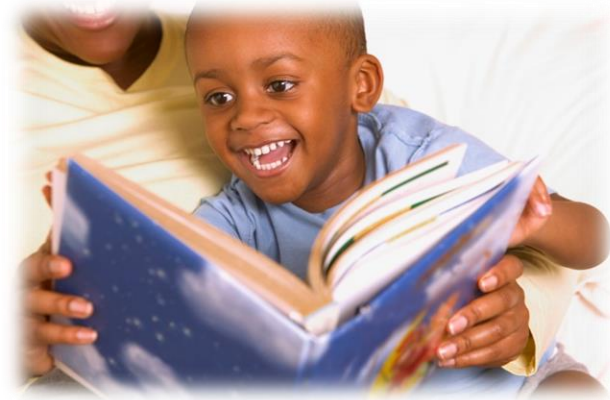

Playclub Program

Introduction

Welcome to the Yangebup Family Centre Playclub program. Playclub was developed as a stepping stone from playgroup to kindy and provides a variety of developmentally appropriate activities for the age group. There is a strong emphasis on parent / child interaction.

Sessions are structured with a degree of flexibility to suit the individual needs of each child in the group. With a focus on creativity and imagination, Playclub provides a fun-filled environment for the children to learn and explore.

Playclub is for children 2-3 years old. To ensure that this program meets the needs of your child we ask that you find alternative arrangements for younger siblings. For some sessions a crèche may be provided. Whilst we discourage the attendance of younger siblings they may attend if they are in a pram, baby sling or similar for the duration of the class.

Enrolment Procedure and Fees

Fees are to be paid in full by week 2 of each term. A non-refundable deposit of 50% of the term fee needs to be paid to confirm your child's enrolment prior to them starting. An enrolment form, child information form, copy of birth certificate and immunisation records all need to be completed before your child can commence one of our programs.

This is a very popular program and we ask that written notification is given to the office staff if you are withdrawing your child.

Weekly Theme

Each term incorporates one or more themes and children can explore these in various ways by joining in with the provided experiences. Themes include colour, shapes, families etc.

News Time

Children are encouraged to bring something of interest from home to tell the other children about at news time. It can be a photo of someone special, a book, some sporting equipment etc. This helps develop your child's language and social skills.

Music and Singing

This is an integral part of the program and simple instruments are sometimes used as an accompaniment to our songs.

What to bring to each session

- a hat for outdoor play
- a healthy snack
- a water bottle
- an item for news

Health

If your child is unwell, please DO NOT come to Playclub. Illness such as influenza, conjunctivitis, gastroenteritis, coughs and colds are highly contagious and spread easily amongst children in this age group. If your child is not attending, please call the centre so we can advise the Playclub facilitator.

Allergies

It is very important that parents advise the Playclub facilitator of any known allergies your child may have. As a precaution NO NUT PRODUCTS are to be brought to Playclub.
